THE HISTORIC SKIRVIN HOTEL

The historic Skirvin Hilton hotel opened to the public in 1911, billed as "The newest, finest hotel in the Southwest." The Skirvin Hilton is one of the best hotels in Oklahoma City and has hosted notable figures as Harry Truman, Dwight D. Eisenhower, Elvis, Frank Sinatra, Jimmy Hoffa, Roger Staubach, Mikhail Baryshnikov, and Bob Hope.

It is conveniently located in the heart of downtown Oklahoma City. Just steps from the hotel's entrance are historic Bricktown and Oklahoma City's major attractions including Myriad Botanical Gardens, the Cox Convention Center, The Chesapeake Energy Arena, Oklahoma City Museum of Art, Civic Center Music Hall and the Oklahoma City National Memorial.

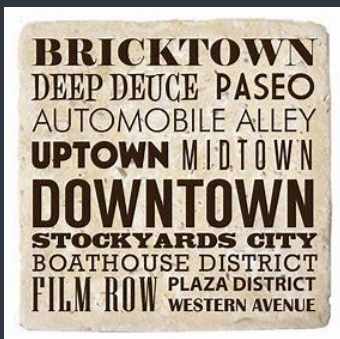

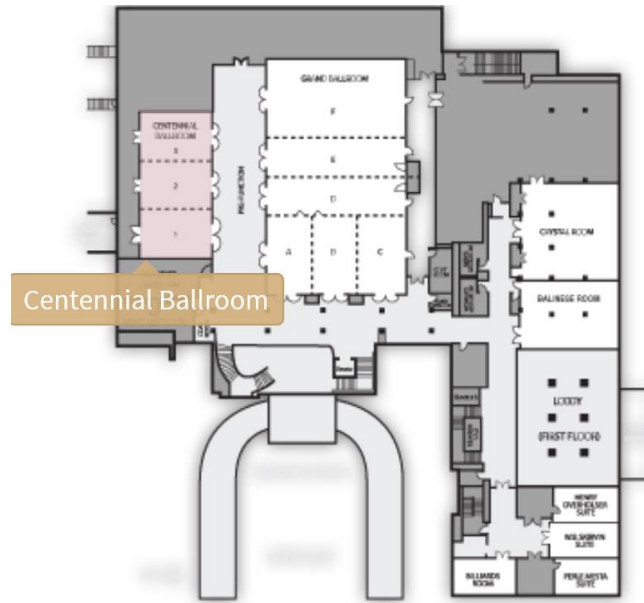

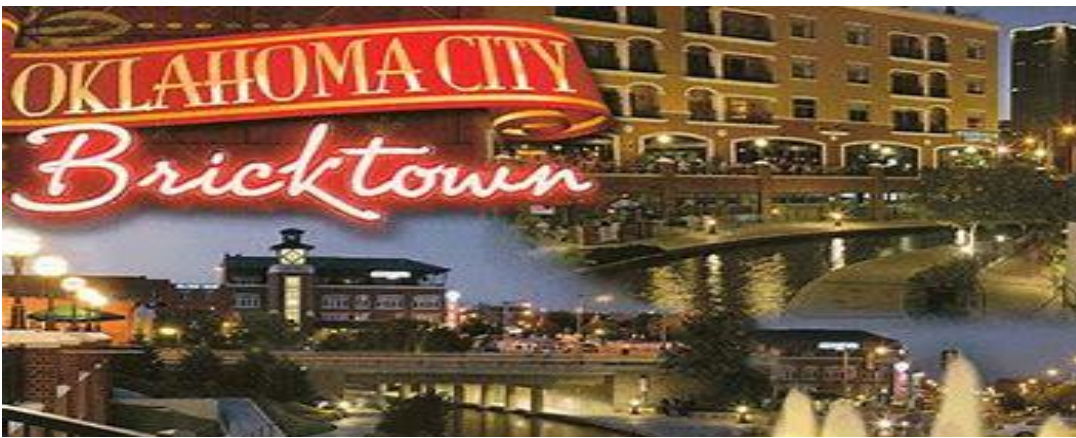
